Even following the downgrade of COVID-19 to a Category 5 infectious disease, follow cautious infection control measures (Excerpt)

April 28th 2023 Gifu Prefectural Taskforce for Preventing the Spread of COVID-19

From May 8th, COVID-19 will be ranked as a Category 5 infectious disease, the same rank as seasonal influenza. As a result, various requests introduced under the special measures law will come to an end.

However, the following remain unchanged in regard to COVID-19:

- COVID-19 is highly transmissible and under the right conditions, infection can spread rapidly.
- The elderly and those with underlying health conditions have a higher risk of serious illness.
- Even those who are asymptomatic may suffer from long Covid.

In view of these circumstances, a document outlining preventative measures following the downgrade of COVID-19 to Category 5 (from May 8th) is attached, and we hereby request that all prefectural residents continue to follow cautious infection control measures.
